Statistics on bilateral trade

The DG trade provides a country-by-country overview of bilateral trade relations which include statistics. Israel is a top trading partner for the EU, with a total commerce amounting at more than \$32 billions. However, as confirmed by the EC, there are no official European statistics on imports of goods from Israeli settlements nor on imports by tariff regime; but a [factsheet](#) on the [EU Delegation](#) site (as well as some press sources) estimates imports amount to 1% of total EU-IL trade.
